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Determining a Policy Need

Considerations when you are thinking about creating a new policy:

- What rules are being broken?
- Are these *legal*, *research-based*, or *preference*?
- What data are supporting this?
- Why are they being broken?
- Are there any existing policies?
- What are the *risks* of not creating a policy?



Policy Ingredients

What to include in your policy document:

- Governing legal or organizational authorities
- Specificity of scope and application
 - Who, what, when, why, where
- Who will enforce the policy?
- What are the *consequences* of violations?
- What are the expectations and mechanisms for feedback and revisions



Implementing a Policy

Steps for getting the policy into practice:

- Identify all relevant stakeholders (mapping)
- New and revised policy approaches
- Solicit feedback and buy-in (this will take time!!)
- Include strategies and processes for:
 - Communications
 - Community reception and feedback
 - Education and training



Maintaining a Policy

Steps for keeping the policy working:

- Keep engaging those stakeholders
 - Listen, communicate, educate
- Solicit and incorporate feedback
- Build additional supporting processes
- Conduct audits
- Enforce consequences
- Engage with Communities of Practice
