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# Determining a Policy Need

Considerations when you are thinking about creating a new policy:

- What rules are being ***broken***?
- Are these ***legal, research-based, or preference***?
- What ***data*** are supporting this?
- ***Why*** are they being broken?
- Are there any ***existing*** policies?
- What are the ***risks*** of not creating a policy?



# Policy Ingredients

What to include in your policy document:

- Governing **legal** or **organizational authorities**
- Specificity of **scope** and **application**
  - Who, what, when, why, where
- Who will **enforce** the policy?
- What are the **consequences** of violations?
- What are the **expectations** and **mechanisms** for **feedback** and **revisions**



# Implementing a Policy

Steps for getting the policy into practice:

- Identify ***all relevant stakeholders*** (mapping)
- ***New*** and ***revised*** policy approaches
- Solicit feedback and buy-in (***this will take time!!***)
- Include strategies and processes for:
  - ***Communications***
  - ***Community reception and feedback***
  - ***Education and training***



# Maintaining a Policy

Steps for keeping the policy working:

- Keep engaging those ***stakeholders***
  - ***Listen, communicate, educate***
- Solicit and ***incorporate feedback***
- Build additional ***supporting processes***
- Conduct ***audits***
- Enforce ***consequences***
- ***Engage*** with Communities of Practice
