



Civil War to Civil Rights, **Downtown Heritage Trail**, is composed of 21 illustrated historical markers, each of which is capped with an **PH**.

The trail is divided into three loops, each of which takes about 60 minutes to walk. You can begin your journey at any point along the route.

- **Center Loop** signs are numbered “.1, .2,” etc.
- **East Loop** signs are numbered “e.1, e.2,” etc.
- **West Loop** signs are numbered “w.1, w.2,” etc.

Sign .1 (Center Loop) is found on Seventh Street just south of its intersection with Pennsylvania Avenue and one-half block from the Archives/ Navy Memorial **M** station on Metro’s Green and Yellow lines.

You can also begin the trail at one of three other downtown **M** Metro stations: Metro Center (near Signs w.1, w.7, .5 and .6), Judiciary Square (near Signs e.2 and e.3), and Gallery Place/Chinatown (near Signs .4 and e.6).
